What will this BTEC National entail?

This will be a practical, work-related course which will cover a range of units (see table) which all Health & Social Care jobs require you have studied at level 3.

The BTEC Nationals in **Health & Social Care** will provide you with a wide range of qualification sizes to choose from - equivalent to 1, 2 or 3 A levels.

Each is designed to ensure that you progress to higher education/training or work.

Progression onto **BTEC Health & Social Care** will require at least 5 GCSEs, or equivalent, at grade 4.
