



Swanshurst Summer School

We delivered a Summer School programme from 10th to 16th August 2021 to support transition from Year 6 to Year 7, with a blend of academic and enrichment activities in accordance with the conditions of the DfE Summer School Programme funding.

Programme Content:

We used the Summer School Programme Funding to run a Summer School which focussed on the teaching and learning of Maths and English along with daily enrichment activities through our Modern Languages, PE and Drama departments. We generously staffed the Summer School to ensure that extra support was always available to pupils – all of whom were given workbooks and revision guides to supplement their learning.

We also promoted confidence and team building through an external Circus Skills team and also through an Art Project – with additional fun from an Escape Room activity.

We designed a timetable of learning which targeted key areas of the National Curriculum in Maths and English selecting content and skills specific to our learner requirements and successfully integrated into the curriculum. This provided targeted content and resources for 1 hour of Maths and 1 hour of English teaching and learning for four days with a day dedicated to team building activities.

We provided lunches and refreshments on site to support the programme and also celebrated success at the end of the week.
