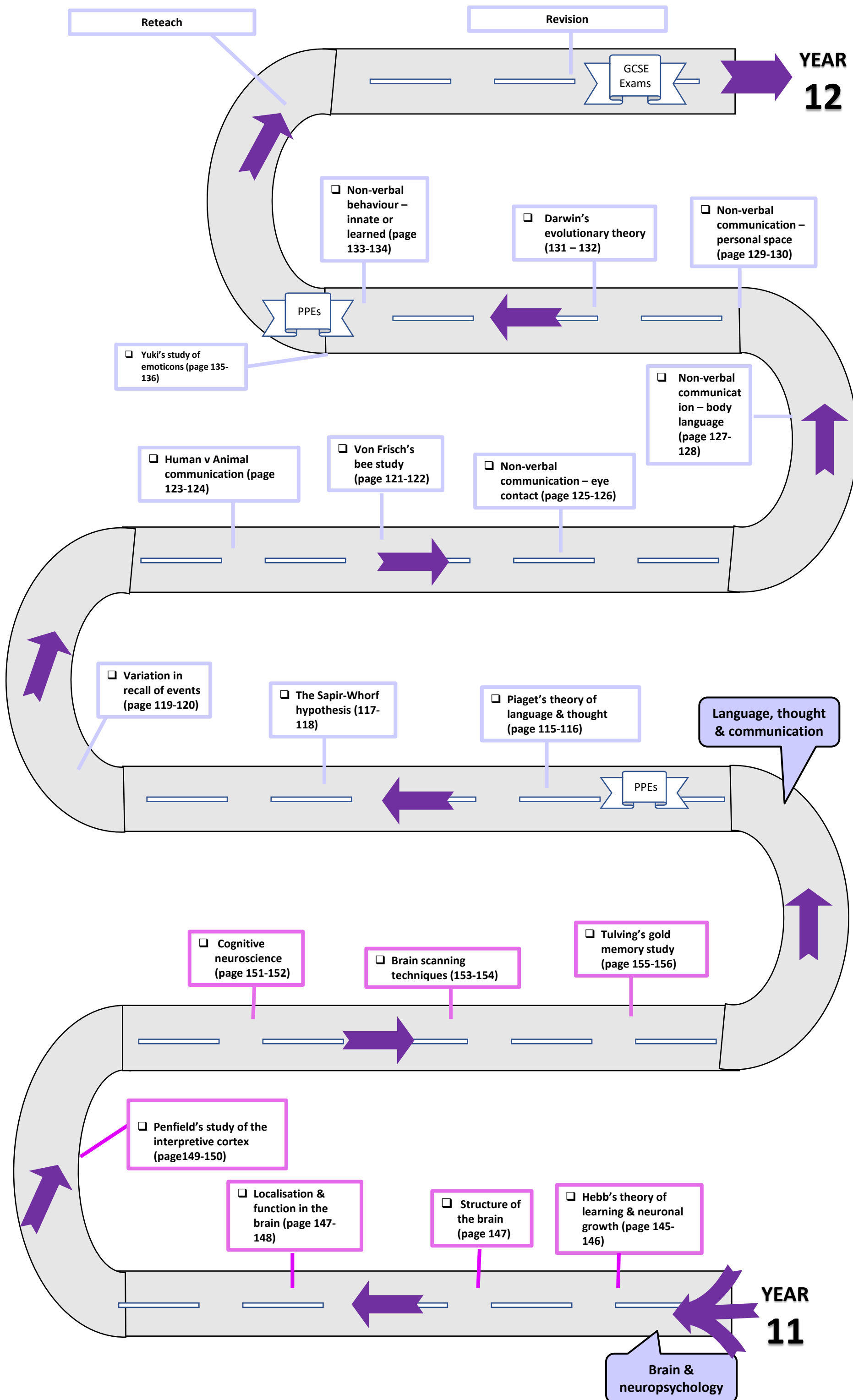




Year 11 Psychology Learning Journey Map
