AO2	You need to be able to apply sociological theories, concepts, evidence and research methods to a variety of questions.	When you apply material, there are significant errors or omissions.	You only give limited application of suitable material and/or you use material that is often at a tangent to the demands of questions.	You can apply content from the general topic area but with limited regard for its relevance to issues raised by questions. Sometimes you can apply a more narrow range of relevant material.	You can apply content that is mainly explicitly relevant to the question. Some of your content is inadequately focused.

You give very limited or no evaluation. When you attempt analysis, it is thin and disjointed.	Your evaluation takes the form of juxtaposition of competing positions or one to two isolated stated points. Your analysis is limited, with mainly descriptive answers.	You give some limited explicit evaluation and/or some appropriate analysis.
